



RULES

Contest : Mobilized for Earth Day

1. General contest description

Share your cycling experience as part of the Mobilized for Earth Day contest and you could win one (1) of four (4) prizes from exo (the Réseau de Transport Métropolitain).

The contest period begins April 22, 2021, and ends May 14, 2021, at 11:59 p.m.

Everyone who completes the entry form will be eligible for the contest draw, subject to the eligibility requirements specified in section 2 of these rules. No purchase is required to enter this contest. The entry form is available at the following website: exo.quebec/bike

2. Eligibility requirements

- Participants must have completed all of the fields of the entry form, including their contact information in the appropriate space.
- Participants must have a valid email address. Only one (1) entry is accepted per email address.
- Participants must be 13 years of age or older or be represented by their parent or guardian.
- Participants may only submit one (1) entry form per individual.
- Participants must correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question.
- Participants must reside in Québec.

exo's directors, officers and employees, partners, suppliers and other representatives, as well as members of their families living in the same household, are not eligible to participate in this contest.

By filling out the online form and providing their contact information, participants (or their legal representatives) consent to allow use of the personal information they provided for the purpose of draws and to contact them as necessary in connection with such draws.

3. Prizes

Four (4) participants will each be awarded, by draw, one (1) of the four (4) following prizes:

- One (1) smart sports bracelet that enables the user to track their activities (steps, heart rate, calories burned, sleep, etc.), valued at \$130.
- One (1) full tune-up and cleaning of a bicycle, provided by Cycle Néron, valued at \$250.*
- Two (2) monthly OPUS passes for the entire territory served by exo (the Réseau de Transport Métropolitain) for the months of July and August 2021, with a total value of \$1,112.
- One (1) indoor smart garden, valued at \$100.

*If the bike's parts are worn out or damaged, the tune-up does not include the cost of replacing them.

4. Winner identification and allocation of prizes

One (1) draw will take place on May 17, 2021, at 2:00 p.m. among all eligible entries.

The list of eligible participants will be exported into Microsoft Excel format. Using the software's automated function, four (4) lines (participants) will be randomly selected among the eligible participants.

The results will be confirmed by an exo representative at the exo head office located at 700 de la Gauchetière Street West, 26th Floor, H3B 5M2. The results will then be published the next business day on the following website: exo.quebec. Only the first and last names of the winners will appear. Winners will also receive an email allowing them to acknowledge receipt and claim their prize.

Only one (1) contest entry is counted per person.

In addition to the above, a person chosen by exo will contact the winner by telephone or email to inform the winner how to collect their prize. Winners will be asked to provide proof of their identity. In the event that a winner refuses or neglects to accept and claim their prize within five (5) business days of the draw, exo will make further draws at 9:00 a.m. on the following day, and every five (5) business days from that date, until all prizes have been claimed.

5. Prize acceptance

Prizes are not exchangeable, transferable or redeemable for cash. Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred to a third party, substituted for another prize, or exchanged in whole or in part.

Refusal or failure to accept or claim a prize absolves exo (the Réseau de Transport Métropolitain) of any obligation related to the prize in question.

The winner shall, at exo's request and prior to taking possession of the prize, sign a form acknowledging receipt of the prize.

6. Changes

To the extent permitted by law, exo reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this contest, in whole or in part, in the event of any incident, error or human intervention that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the contest as provided for in these rules, subject to the approval of the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec, as required. In all cases, exo and its employees, agents, representatives and assigns may not be required to award more prizes than those set out in these rules or award prizes not in accordance with these rules.

7. Waiver of liability

Exo, its employees, agents and representatives may not be held liable for Internet or website malfunctions, problems or technical disturbances of any network or telephone line or of any online computer systems, servers, address suppliers, hardware or software, electronic message transmission or reception failures, any damage or loss caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by downloading any Internet page or any software, technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or any website or any combination thereof, including damage to a contest entrant's computer or the computer of any other person used to enter the contest, to receive any materials about the contest or to accept any prize.
